## **Republic Square**

is the heart of the city. Square is the only one in its type, endowed by singing fountains and a magnificent mosaic rock carpet, which covers 3000-year-old ruins underneath it! The Republic Square and the all the building circling it were designed by Alexander Tamanyan. The great oval of the Square will give you a great chance to examine Tamanyan's distinctive designs in detail.



#### Matenadaran

Matenadaran or the Mesrop Mashtots Institute of Ancient Manuscripts is a repository of ancient manuscripts, research institutes, and museums.

It holds one of the world's richest depositories of medieval manuscripts and books. The Matenadaran is in possession of a collection of nearly 17,000 manuscripts and 30,000 other documents covering a wide array of subjects.

### **Blue Mosque**

is an 18th-century Shia mosque in Yerevan. During the soviet era, the mosque stopped its service and housed the History Museum of Yerevan. Following Armenian's acting as a mosque mostly for Iranians residing in the country. It is currently the only active mosque in Armenia.



#### **Yerevan Cascade**

The Cascade is a giant stairway made of limestone in Yerevan. It links the downtown Kentron area of Yerevan with the Monument neighborhood. Inside the Cascade, underneath the exterior steps, are seven escalators that rise along the length of the complex. There are also exhibit halls connected to some of the landings along the escalators which compose the Cafesjian Museum of Art.
